



RAIN SENSOR REBATE REQUIREMENTS

ACWWA is committed to water conservation. ACWWA will rebate certain water account customers up to 50% of the purchase price (maximum \$50) on the cost of a rain sensor (installation costs are not covered).

INSTRUCTIONS:

- All applicants must include: completed application, copy of entire receipt, signed Affidavit with copy of identification.
- To qualify for the program, a copy of the entire receipt needs to be attached to the Rebate form and submitted within 90 days of purchase date. Rebate program is first-come, first-served. Limited funds are dedicated for the program. When funds are exhausted, the program ends.

TERMS:

- Program applies to Arapahoe County Water and Wastewater Authority water account customers only. Account must be in good standing.
- Rebate offer allows for a maximum of one rain sensor per single family residence. Rebates will not be issued for rain sensors installed in apartment or condo common areas.
- The rebate amount cannot exceed 50% of the actual cost of the rain sensor.
- Rain sensor must be installed in the ACWWA service area. ACWWA reserves the right to inspect the premises in order to verify installation of the rain sensor prior to issuing the rebate.
- **Each new rain sensor must be on the approved list.**

Neither ACWWA, nor its contractors and agents, makes any representation or warranty regarding the rain sensors eligible for rebates under this Rebate Program. By participating in the rebate program, the customer waives and releases ACWWA and its contractors and agents from any and all claims and causes of action arising out of the purchase, installation, inspection, or use of the rain sensor in connection with the Rebate Program.

**RESIDENTIAL RAIN SENSOR
REBATE APPLICATION**

**Rebates apply only to qualifying items purchased between January 1 and December 31, 2012.
Follow these steps to earn your rebate:**

- 1) First purchase a qualifying rain sensor and submit rebate request within **90 days of purchase date**. All wired and wireless rain sensor models that connect to an automatic, in-ground irrigation system are eligible for the rebate.
- 2) Attach a copy of the entire receipt, which must include the date, rain sensor brand, and rain sensor model number in order to qualify. (Keep the original for your records.)
- 3) Complete this application and the affidavit attached. Submit a copy of your identification along with this application, a copy of the receipt, and the signed affidavit to ACWWA within 90 days of purchase date.

REBATE AFFIDAVIT

As of July 31, 2006, you must prove lawful presence in the United States in order to receive the benefit of the rebate:

At the time this form was printed, forms of identification acceptable to the Colorado Department of Revenue include:

- A valid Colorado driver's license;
- A valid Colorado identification card;
- A current driver's license or identification card with applicant's photograph issued by one of the following: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wyoming;
- United States Passport (except "limited" – issued for 5 years or less)
- A United States military card;
- A United States military dependent's identification card;
- A United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card;
- A Native American tribal document;
- A naturalization or citizenship certificate;
- An I-94 immigration form with refugee or asylum status; or
- An unexpired resident alien card, permanent resident card, temporary resident card, or employment authorization card;
- Any other form authorized by the Colorado Department of Revenue.

Please mail a photocopy of your identification (in one of the forms listed above) and your signed affidavit along with the other rebate paperwork. **You may remove/darken all sensitive information such as driver's license numbers or social security numbers from the copy of your ID that you submit to ACWWA.**
