Water is an essential resource for the prosperity of Arapahoe County's business corridor. Arapahoe County Water and Wastewater Authority (ACWWA) is thinking ahead and taking action to develop a secure water supply for the businesses in our service area.

For more than 10 years, ACWWA's Board has pursued additional and renewable (non-diminishing) water supplies in sufficient quantity and quality. Recently, the years of planning became a reality as ACWWA completed a \$153 million dollar transaction to acquire renewable water from the South Platte River Basin, and to develop an infrastructure to deliver water to the Authority's service area.
